Welcome to Glen Road Medical centre. It is a purpose built premises with access and facilities for disabled patients and play area for children in waiting area.

The team consists of 3 Doctors, Practice Nurse, Specialist Diabetic Nurse, Psychiatric Nurse, Health Care assistant, Counsellor, Dietician, District Nurse, Health Visitor for elderly, Practice Manager, Receptionist, Secretarial and other attached Primary care staff

Access/Appointments

We operate an appointment system for Doctors and nurses. As per our Access Policy we are required to give an appointment within 48 hours with any doctor or a medical person and not a doctor of your choice. If you insist on seeing a particular doctor then you need to wait for the first available appointment for the doctor of your choice.

Home Visits:

Patients who are severely disabled, elderly or too ill to attend the surgery, could request for a home visit before 10:00am. (not having transport is not a valid reason to request home visit by the doctor).

Facilities for the Disabled:

Glen Road Medical Centre is a purpose built premises with full disabled access. There is a wheelchair access to the consulting rooms and treatment room. The practice has a disabled toilet.

Special Clinics and services:

Well person: Any patient aged 16-75 may have screening and health checks, which include blood pressure, weight, and height measurement and also other health related advice. Well person checks are done every 3 years. Please book an appointment to see the Practice Nurse.

Practice Nurse / Midwives / Health Visitors / other health professional:

You can obtain the following services, which are provided by the Nurse, Midwife, Health visitors, and other health professionals by contacting the practice.

New Patients Registration Clinic:

New Patients can register and remain on the list only if they live in the practice catchment area. Please ring surgery for further details of the catchment area and to arrange an appointment.

The new patient registration clinic is held on most days of the week. **Valid proof of identification and address should be produced on the day of the appointment.** If there are any children under 5 years of age, it is important to bring in their red book/ immunisation book.

Repeat Prescriptions:

Repeat prescriptions may be obtained by ticking the appropriate boxes on computer printed re-order form, at the surgery or by post by sending a self addressed stamped envelope. **We do not accept telephone request for repeat prescriptions.**

Please allow 48 hours notice for collection of repeat prescriptions from the surgery or it will be returned if self-addressed envelope is provided with the request.

Repeat medication prescriptions are given subject to periodic review by one of the doctors. Please book an appointment for medication review when due.

Test Results:

For test results please ring the surgery from Monday to Friday except on Wednesdays between 15:00pm – 16:00hrs.
